

Preparing To View A Property

- 1. Please let us know before your viewing if you or anyone in your household is sick or showing any possible COVID-19 symptoms, or has been in contact with anyone who is sick or showing possible COVID-19 symptoms.
- 2. We will ask if you are able to walk, cycle or drive to the viewing. We advise against taking public transport but if you must we will book your viewing to commence during off-peak hours (to avoid rush hour).
- 3. Please be aware that we will only admit a maximum of two people from the same household to view a property.
- 4. Please arrive on time this helps avoid groups of people gathering near the property.
- 5. Please do not shake our agent's hand (they won't be offended!) and please observe social distancing and be particularly cautious in smaller properties.
- 6. Please wear face masks to your viewing.
- 7. Please put on a pair of clean gloves prior to entering the property.
- 8. Please brand hand sanitiser so that you can wash your hands prior and post viewing.
- 9. Please avoid touching anything in the property if you need to please ask the agent conducting the viewing.
- 10. If you could please wait before asking questions until after the viewing so we can get in and out as soon as possible. We'd recommend bringing a pen and paper so you can make notes.
- I. Please be aware that we are currently not giving out property brochures, to minimise potential spread. You can download the property brochure for any property by clicking 'Info Sheet' on the property listing on our website. We will send you a digital copy of any other relevant information and paperwork.
