

## Preparing For People Accessing Your Property (Contractors + Tradespeople)

- 1. Please let us know before the viewing if you or anyone in your household is sick or showing any possible COVID-19 symptoms, or has been in contact with anyone who is sick or showing possible COVID-19 symptoms. If you booked the appointment directly with the contractor, photographer, surveyor or other person you must notify them directly.
- 2. Before the contractor and/or tradesperson is due to access your property please open all internal doors. This stops the contractor or tradesperson from having to touch surfaces and helps create airflow around your property.
- 3. If it's safe to do so please also open your windows prior to the appointment.
- 4. Whilst social distancing is currently not mandatory we do ask that you please try to maintain a safe distance between yourself and our contractors and/or tradesperson, for everyone's safety. Please do not shake the contractor and/or tradesperson's hand (they won't be offended!).
- 5. Wearing a mask is also no longer mandatory. However, if you feel safer wearing one please do so. If you would like our contractors and/or tradesperson to wear one please let us know as soon as possible prior to the appointment or visit.
- 6. If possible, please wipe down any surfaces the contractor or tradesperson may need to touch before the appointment.
- 7. Make sure to clean surfaces after the appointment.

These measures are to keep you, your household, our contractors and tradespeople safe. Thank you for your patience.
