

Preparing To View A Property

- 1. Please let us know before your viewing if you or anyone in your household is sick or showing any possible COVID-19 symptoms, or has been in contact with anyone who is sick or showing possible COVID-19 symptoms.
- 2. We will ask if you are able to walk, cycle or drive to the viewing. We advise against taking public transport but if you must we will book your viewing to commence during off-peak hours (to avoid rush hour).
- 3. Please be aware that we will only admit a maximum of two adults from the same household to view a property.
- 4. Please arrive on time this helps avoid groups of people gathering near the property.
- 5. Please do not shake our agent's hand (they won't be offended!)
- 6. Whilst social distancing is currently not mandatory we do ask that you please try to maintain a safe distance from our agent, particularly in smaller enclosed spaces.
- 7. Wearing a mask is also no longer mandatory. However, if you feel safer wearing one please do so. If you would like our agent to wear one please let us know when booking your viewing.
- 8. Please bring hand sanitiser so that you can wash your hands prior and post viewing.
- 9. Please avoid touching anything in the property if you need to please ask the agent conducting the viewing.
- 10. Please be aware that we are currently not giving out property brochures to minimise potential spread. You can download the property brochure for any property by clicking 'Info Sheet' on the property listing on our website. We will send you a digital copy of any other relevant information and paperwork.
